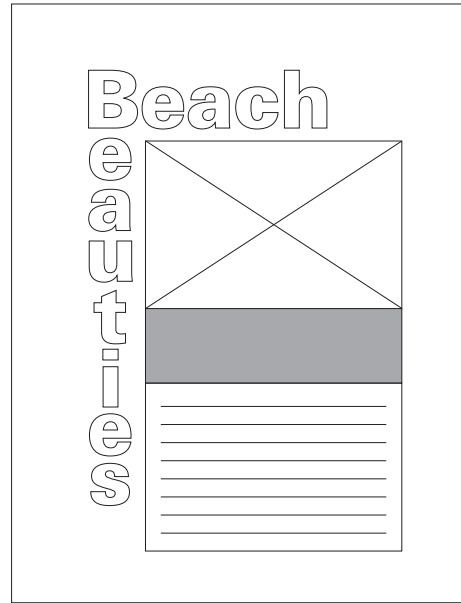
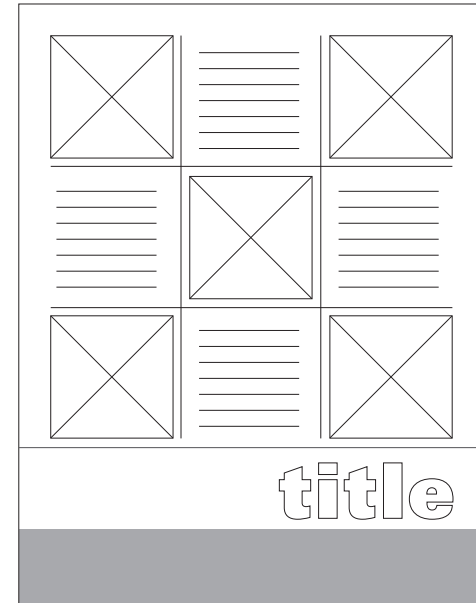


- 11 **Think BIG:** Slap an oversize title roughly in the middle of your page, and build your page around this creative centerpiece.
- 12 **Play hide-and-seek:** Hide your journaling sentiments in a homemade word search.
- 13 **Go photo-less:** Skip the photos, and tell a story with a cute title and meaningful journaling.
- 14 **Say it in stitches:** Lightly sketch a simple title (like "LOVE") in pencil on your layout's background; then machine stitch the letters in a contrasting color.



- 15 **Design across and down:** Arrange a two-word title (like "Beach Beauties") crossword style, with one word vertical and the other horizontal.
- 16 **Assume an alter ego:** Write your journaling from the point of view of an inanimate object. How would the toaster view your morning breakfast routine?
- 17 **Repurpose old photos:** Die-cut letters for your title out of duplicate prints, concentrating on colorful background areas (grass, sky, fabric, painted walls, etc.).
- 18 **Scrapbook like it's 1999:** Draw your title in fancy block letters, complete with faux shading, and handwrite your journaling.



- 19 **Play tic-tac-toe:** Arrange photos and journaling blocks into a nine-square grid.
- 20 **Be cheap:** Cut letters from an alphabet-themed patterned paper, and piece together a cute, inexpensive title.
- 21 **Pay homage:** Model your title after a favorite book or film: "A Series of Unfortunate ER Visits" or "The Incredible Shrinking Waistline" (we wish!).
- 22 **Use your own words:** Scan, photocopy, or tear out an actual page from a past or current journal, and add it to a scrapbook page.
